As health services battle against a global pandemic and an increasing demand on their services, medical leaders seek to find the next generation of heroes to take up these life-saving roles. We know that the variety of roles within nursing requires a huge diversity in skills – from utilising cutting edge technology to leading teams during a crisis.

Having worked with over 1 million young people in ten years, Speakers for Schools is best placed to introduce the world of nursing to young people who would not have considered it before.

Speakers for Schools will run a range of programmes aimed at introducing future talent into the sector. We aim to introduce at least **1,350 young people** to the world of nursing through virtual insight days and virtual work experience between **January and March 2021**. These services will be run by expert nurses, and industry leaders with a focus on addressing young people's preconceptions about a career in nursing.

We are working closely with the Chief Nursing Officer, regional Chief Nurses and key NHS networks such as the Black Men in Nursing Group who will advise on attracting more BAME young men to the profession. Our Inspiration talks team are recruiting for inspiring speakers across the health sector such as St John Ambulance who have an impressive network of 7,000 young cadets.

Nursing is one of the most varied professions in the world and we want to make sure the next generation of nurses have the wide range of skills needed. Our work experience and insight days will show young people the exciting opportunities that a career in nursing can offer.
