

## Terms and Conditions: The Great British Food Critic Competition

### Aim:

To provide young people with a comprehensive overview and guidance from catering and hospitality experts on how to begin a career in these sectors.

### Rules:

Calling all students aged 11-19!

To Enter, write a review of 300 words, include photos of the food and include @speakersforschools @rogan\_simon and tag/name your school and the hashtag #TGBFC, videos/TikToks/Reels are also invited for the competition. The competition is open to all young people at state schools and colleges aged 11 – 19. If you are under 13, make sure you ask the school to post on their social media using the hashtag #TGBFC.

The winner will be announced LIVE during an online inspiration broadcast during National Careers Week (NCW).

### Terms and conditions

1. The competition opens at 10am on January 9<sup>th</sup> and closes at 23:59 on February 26<sup>th</sup>. Entries submitted outside of these times will be invalid.
2. Both accounts (@speakersforschools @rogan\_simon) must be tagged with the hashtag and #TGBFC for entries to be valid.
3. Under 13s cannot use social media so the school will need to post on their behalf.
4. Only one entry is allowed per student; all entries must include a visual of the food. Please include the name of your school for state school verification.
5. All valid entries will be reviewed and whittled down to a shortlist of 10, from which one winner and three runners-up will be chosen.
6. This competition is in no way affiliated with Facebook, Twitter, Instagram or TikTok.
7. Prizes cannot be swapped or exchanged but can be revoked if competition rules have been broken (e.g. a student aged 22 enters).
