# Seenit videos

National Teen Book Club (NTBC) brings together 11 to 19 year olds from state schools and colleges across the UK in a shared, virtual book club. If you are an educator with students wanting to engage more with our featured book, other NTBClubbers and our speakers; or with students who feel less comfortable or able to contribute to Book Club discussions, use this pack to guide them through an alternative activity.

Seenit videos are a fantastic way for young people to practise communication and presentation skills and to represent NTBC – we may showcase their clips during live and recorded NTBC sessions and as part of our marketing too!

Simply click on our hyperlinks or scan the QR Codes with a mobile device to get started. Students will then need to click on the scene and tap the record button to film according to the time limit. They could speak to camera or, if they would prefer not to be filmed, they could create a video of their written words with/without audio! It will help to read our prompts first, however, clips can be re-recorded before they are shared. When students are ready to submit a video, they'll need to click the consent box and tap on 'Upload securely'. Easy!
